Dear LRPC Commissioners and Interested Parties:

Earlier this year, volatile and uncertain fuel supplies and rates reached crisis levels in NH. The Governor set up a special task force to explore and develop an effective response prior to the onset of the winter heating season. Amid growing concerns about climate change, public interest in renewable or alternative energy supplies also emerged, and the topic of energy is now frequently discussed in local energy committees, businesses, and at everyone's kitchen table.

The state of NH holds the world record for the highest recorded wind speed on earth, which reflects ample opportunity to tap power from the wind. In 2008, the state of NH passed a law (RSA 674:63) pertaining to the regulation of small wind energy systems. However, the siting of wind turbines is one of the more contentious issues, due to perceived negative visual and noise impacts.

Please make it a special point to attend the November 17 LRPC Commission meeting in Tamworth when current wind power regulations and applications will be presented by state practitioners. We invite you to bring a friend to learn and to share your experiences with wind energy: a powerful, renewable source of energy with critical land use challenges.
