TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECT APPLICATION PERIOD BEGINS
2009-1010 PROJECTS SEEKING FUNDING MUST BE SUBMITTED BY JULY 1

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) announces the start of the 2009-2010 application cycle for the Transportation Enhancements (TE) program. The TE program is a federally funded grant program that has provided up to 80% of funds for the planning and construction of nearly 300 municipally managed transportation projects in New Hampshire since the mid-1990's.

Examples of TE projects include: pedestrian and bicycle paths and safety programs, scenic and historic highway programs, landscaping and scenic beautification, historic preservation, and environmental mitigation. The schedule for the 2009-2010 Application is as follows:

- **June 1, 2009:** Application cycle announced and application/guidance document released.
- **July 2, 2009:** Letters of intent due to NHDOT and Regional Planning Commissions by 3:00 pm.
- **July/August 2009:** Mandatory Municipally Managed Project Workshops to be scheduled around the state.
- **September 15, 2009:** Completed applications due to NHDOT and Regional Planning Commissions by 3:00 pm.
