- Would you know if some were missing?

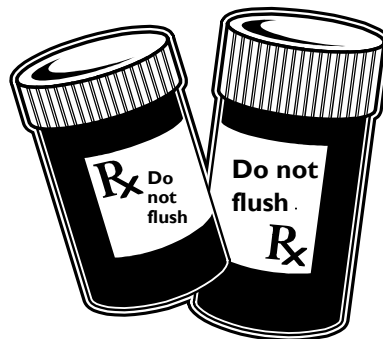
To help prevent prescription drug abuse, please take the following steps:

### **I. SAFEGUARD ALL DRUGS. MONITOR QUANTITIES AND CONTROL**

**ACCESS.** Take note of how many pills are in a bottle and keep track of refills. If you find you have to refill medication more often than expected, someone may be taking your medication without your knowledge.

### **2. PROPERLY CONCEAL AND DISPOSE OF OLD AND UNUSED MEDICINES.**

Do not flush drugs down the toilet as they can pollute the water supply.
