### What's Involved— Volunteer Monitor Duties

#### Lake Sampling—

- Weekly or biweekly sampling of a specific site
- Boat with long anchor line
- Willingness to do some simple processing of the water samples.
- Time commitment— 1 hr per site

#### Tributary Sampling—

- Biweekly or monthly
- Approx. 1/2 hr per site

Sampling is done generally between May – Sept.

No experience necessary, training will be provided by the UNH Lakes Lay Monitoring Program or NH Volunteer River Assessment Program
