On Monday, March 30, 2015 at the Moultonborough Town Hall, 6 Holland Street, Moultonborough, NH the Lakes Region Planning Commission will hold its regular Commissioner meeting to discuss the value and importance of local Hazard Mitigation Plans (HMPs). The panel for this discussion includes federal, state and local perspectives on why municipal officials should consider this planning tool for their community.
